

Dock / Dry Hoist / Launch Ramp Application



Dock / Dry Hoist / Launch Ramp Rules

1. Members in good standing may submit an application for dock assignment with the payment of a \$400.00 deposit prior to February 28th.
Filing an application after this date will result in loss of priority for docking.
Filing an application after this date will result in a \$25.00 late charge.
2. Dock, Dry Hoist and Launch Ramp rates and special assessments are set by the DYC Board and published in the club newsletter, "The Breeze", and also posted on the Club's website at www.discoverdyc.com. See the Fee Schedule, under the 'Member Resources' tab.
3. Applicants should review the terms and conditions for Members listed in the Club By-Laws, which are posted in the Members' Handbook on the Club's website; under the Members Only tab.
4. Members' boats must be in DYC docks by May 20th unless special arrangements are made with the Dock Chairman. Otherwise the dock will be reassigned and the \$400.00 dock application deposit is forfeited.
5. Dock rental fees, deposits, and special assessments non- refundable.
6. Dock rental fees include summer cradle storage for knock-down cradles only.
7. Cradle knock-down must be completed within one week after launch. The Club fee is \$60.00 to perform knock-down and prepare your cradle for storage.
8. Trailer and non-knock-down cradle storage requires an application and a \$75.00 fee which must be submitted by May 15th. A late fee of \$25.00 applies thereafter.
9. The initial docks allocation is to members in good standing who submitted applications before February 28th. Remaining vacant docks will be assigned, in a secondary round of docks allocation. Docks shall be assigned by the Dock Chair for the benefit of all members and in the best interests of the Club. A member shall normally have first option to use a dock that was assigned for the previous season, but is not guaranteed that dock. Docks not assigned in the initial allocation will be offered to members, on the basis of fit, best interest of the club, special needs, and dock points.
10. New Members will be charged the usual fees, prorated to the date of joining the Club. Docks assigned to new members during the season are subject to reallocation.
11. Members may occupy only the dock number assigned to them by the Dock Chair.
12. Members may occupy their assigned dock with the boat identified in this application only.
13. Vacated docks will be announced to all members by email. Members who request to change on their dock application will be contacted by the Dock Chair should their choice become vacant. Vacated docks will be reassigned on the basis of fit, best interest of the club, special needs, and dock points.
14. A member vacating a dock for one year may retain priority for that dock by paying their regular, full dock rental fee for that year.
15. When there is waiting list for docks, a member shall be assigned one dock only.
16. A Member who sells their boat, or who is expelled, or who has their membership revoked, must remove their boat from DYC docks, walls and property within 7days.
17. DYC reserves the right to use any dock vacant for more than 24 hours for a visitor boat. Please notify the Club Manager or Harbour Office employee of the dates when you will be away.
18. Members are required to maintain a minimum of \$1,000,000 Public Liability & Property Damage Insurance.
19. All boats must be removed from DYC's floating docks prior to Docks Out. Any boat left on a floating dock on the morning of Docks Out will be subject to a \$100.00 fine.
