CONDITIONS OF STORAGE

1. No boat or trailer may be stored on Dalhousie Yacht Club property without an approved or completed application. Only members in good standing may submit an application by September 30th.
2. All boats, cradles, trailers etc. will only be placed where directed by the Yard Chairman.
3. All cradles must be knock-down type.
4. Members wishing to store vessels longer than a winter season must apply in writing for extended storage. Long term (in excess of 12 months) storage is charged at 3 times the normal rate. Maximum yard storage of 3 years.
5. Should a boat be placed in an inappropriate location, as a result of long term storage (i.e. exceeding the normal winter season), and is deemed necessary by the Board to be relocated, the costs shall be borne by the owner.
6. Boats will be lifted as scheduled by the Board and in order as directed by the Yard Chairman.
7. Prior to lifting, slings are to be placed as directed by the boat owner and must be tied horizontally to prevent slipping. The owner of the vessel is responsible for placement and securing of the lifting slings.
8. Cradles, trailers and support blocks must be clearly identified with the owner's and boat's name and all must be in good repair and capable of safely supporting the boat. Unsafe cradles, as determined by the Yard Chairman, may result in the refusal by the Club to provide either crane service or storage or both.
9. Water and electrical services are provided to each storage area. The Board does not guarantee accessibility or availability of these services to every storage position.
10. Charges for storage and crane service will be as determined by the Board and published in the Breeze.
11. Normal seasonal maintenance, only, is permitted on Club property. Exterior repairs or refurbishing of boats is not permitted on club property.

I, The undersigned as owner or on behalf of the owner for whom I am entitled to act, hereby agree to 1) indemnify and hold harmless Dalhousie Yacht Club, its Members and Employees from any and all liability arising out of the Crane Service and Boat Storage provided pursuant to the Conditions of Storage Agreement on this form and 2) waive any and all claims against the Club, its Members and Employees arising out of the Crane Service and Boat Storage pursuant to the Conditions of Storage Agreement on this form and 3) confirm that I have and will maintain Public Liability and Damage Insurance on my boat in the amount of at least \$1,000,000.00 a copy of proof of insurance is attached to this application.
